



## **CREATING THE CLIMATE FOR FACULTY ENGAGEMENT**

In this presentation, Dianne Cyr will discuss the Community College of Denver Model for Faculty Engagement. The session will include an overview of the CCD's award-winning Teaching/Learning Center and its approach to faculty professional development including best practices, lessons learned and next steps. This will be an interactive session with opportunity for discussion and questions throughout.

This session will also reference the *Seven Principles for Good Practice in Undergraduate Education* as compiled in a 1986 study by the American Association for Higher Education, the Education Commission of the States and the Johnson Foundation and the accompanying *Faculty Inventory of Good Practice in Undergraduate Education*. The purpose of the Inventory is the improvement of undergraduate education; not the evaluation of individual units, faculty or administrators. Group discussion will relate the inventory to the principals of the learning college and toward creating more educationally powerful environments.
