Indicators of a Culture of Evidence

- *Systematic collection, analysis, and reporting of key data on student progress and success*

Indicators of a Culture of Evidence

Student Outcomes:

- Successful completion of remedial/ developmental courses*
- Progress from remedial/ developmental courses to college-level courses*
- Successful completion of selected gatekeeper courses (e.g., College Algebra, Anatomy & Physiology, etc.)*
- Rate of successful course completion for all courses (grade of C or better)*
- Student persistence – re-enrollment term-to-term*
- Completion of certificates and associate degrees*
